Yes, we're buried under snow and ice...but it's never too soon to start planning for the spring soccer season! La Crescent Youth Soccer Association / Coulee Region Minnesota (LYSA/CRM) announces the dates and times for the spring soccer league registration along with registration information.

LYSA/CRM soccer is offered to all La Crescent-area youth ages 5-14 interested in a recreational soccer experience. Fairly equal playtime is encouraged.

We are an *all volunteer* organization--this program doesn't happen all by itself! We need many people to fill a wide variety of positions. You don't need to be a soccer expert to get involved. Kind, enthusiastic parents are encouraged to help. Most needed are coaches and parent representatives for each team. Contact any board member or Volunteer Coordinator Kathy Duerwachter to get involved.

Program Fees

U7-10: \$70

- **U7-10:** Teams are formed by gender and play in the Park & Rec league. Games are on Tuesday or Thursday and Saturday mornings, a practice is held during the week. Teams play home and away games and may travel to cities such as Onalaska, Holman and West Salem. Not all cities have teams in each age group, so travel schedules aren't certain until about two weeks before the league begins.

Sign up for individual grade

Boys grades 1,2,3,4

Girls grades 1,2,3,4

Grades 1&2 play games on Tues./Sat.

Grades 3&4 play games on Thurs./Sat.

Boys will play in boy's league and girls will play in girl's league.

Why a January 29th Deadline?

1. Teams need to be submitted by February
2. Coaches need to be properly trained at coaching clinic (Volunteer parent coaches NEEDED)
3. Equipment needs to be ordered and distributed
4. Fields need to be reserved and maintained
5. Teams are created to allow for adequate and equal playing time as well as necessary breaks, teams rely on players attending practices and games.
6. Train referees

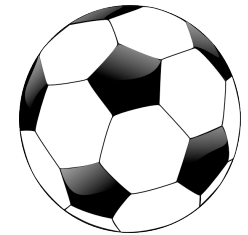
Turn in your registration form and payment. Order socks, shin guards, shorts and other LYSA spirit wear and items for pickup on March 24th.

First time player?

Players are provided a jersey that is returned at the end of the season. Players also need:

- Cleats
- Socks (available for purchase at Registration Fair)
- Shin guards (under socks)
- Black shorts
- Water for games and practices
- Warm clothes for games and practices

Soccer is played rain or shine. Always call your team parent rep if you are unsure about weather conditions.

Soccer Equipment Exchange
